OBJECTIVES OF WAYNFLETE INFANTS' SCHOOL

The principal object and activity of the Academy is to provide education for pupils of different abilities between the ages of 4 and 7.

In accordance with the articles of association the Academy has adopted the funding agreement approved by the Secretary of State for Education. The Funding Agreement specifies, amongst other things, the basis for admitting students to the Academy, the catchment area from which the students are drawn, and that the curriculum should comply with the substance of the national curriculum.

The main objectives, strategies and activities of WIS are :

- to ensure that every child enjoys the same high quality education in terms of resourcing, tuition and care irrespective of race, culture, gender, disability or social demographic;
- to raise the standard of educational achievement of all pupils;
- to improve the effectiveness of the Academy by keeping the curriculum and organisational structure under continual review;

- to comply with all appropriate statutory and curriculum requirements;
- to maintain close links with industry, commerce and the local community;
- to ensure that the Academy's plans for sustainability in relation to finance, premises, resources and staffing;
- to conduct the Academy's business in accordance with the highest standards of integrity, probity and openness; and
- to ensure that the building and grounds are fit for purpose, and provides a safe and stimulating learning environment.

- having educationalists that are able to specialise in EYFS and Key Stage 1;
